- Review is needed to address gaps identified by legal review by Harrison Pensa LLP
- Discussion led by Adam Grant
- Examples of issues identified:
  - Bylaw #7 pg. 26 vs. Bylaw #9... differences in creating a new entity of CIPHI
  - Historical practice has some influence on the current operation and possible future operations of the BOC
  - Disjoint in how #7 is written to indicate the BOC is a separate entity
- Discussion of Objects
  - To take over the assets and liabilities of "The Sanitary Inspectors' Association of Canada" established under the name of "The



Sanitary Inspectors' Association of Western Canada" on the 19th day of April, A.D. 1913, and to enter into such agreements and to make, do and execute all such acts, deeds, matters and things as may be necessary for the purpose of taking over such assets and liabilities or any part thereof;

- Leave in for historical purposes and continuity
- Suggest addition of: To assume the assets and liabilities of "The Sanitary Inspectors' Association of Canada" ... assuming and ... maintaining such assets... on an ongoing basis...
- To promote the advancement of sanitary science in all or any of its branches, and the diffusion of knowledge relating thereto, either in all or any of the ways hereinafter specified or in any other way;
  - needs revision to update
  - change 'sanitary science' to 'environmental public health'
  - change to wording of mission statement.
  - CIPHI advances the profession, science and the field of Environmental Public Health through certification, advocacy, education and setting standards. We protect the health of Canadians and represent Environmental Public Health professionals across Canada.
- To raise the status, standards and rewards of the Sanitary Inspector. To secure that persons appointed as Sanitary Inspectors, Meat, Food and Dairy Inspectors, and cognate positions in Health Departments, shall have passed a qualifying examination in some branch of Sanitary science;
