‡ NOTE: From 1934 to 1952 non-members and members who received a recognition award from the Institute were all awarded **Honorary Membership**. In 1952 a review of the bylaws concluded this was incorrect and a new recognition award of **Life Membership** was proposed. This change to the bylaws was approved at the 1953 AGM. In addition, Section 5, CISI By-Law #1 1953 directed that, *“Those persons voted to Honorary Membership prior to the passing of these by-laws be recognized under the appropriate section of these revised by-laws.”* Thus Regular and Retired Members awarded **Honorary Membership** up to 1953 have been changed to **Life Membership**.
