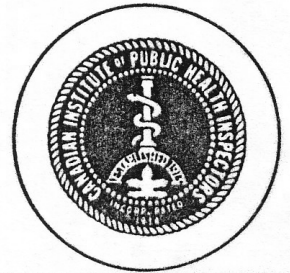

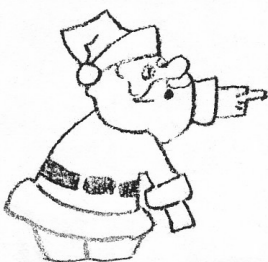
PROFILE

White Spot Limited is the largest food service employer in British Columbia, with 2500 employees working in its various establishments.

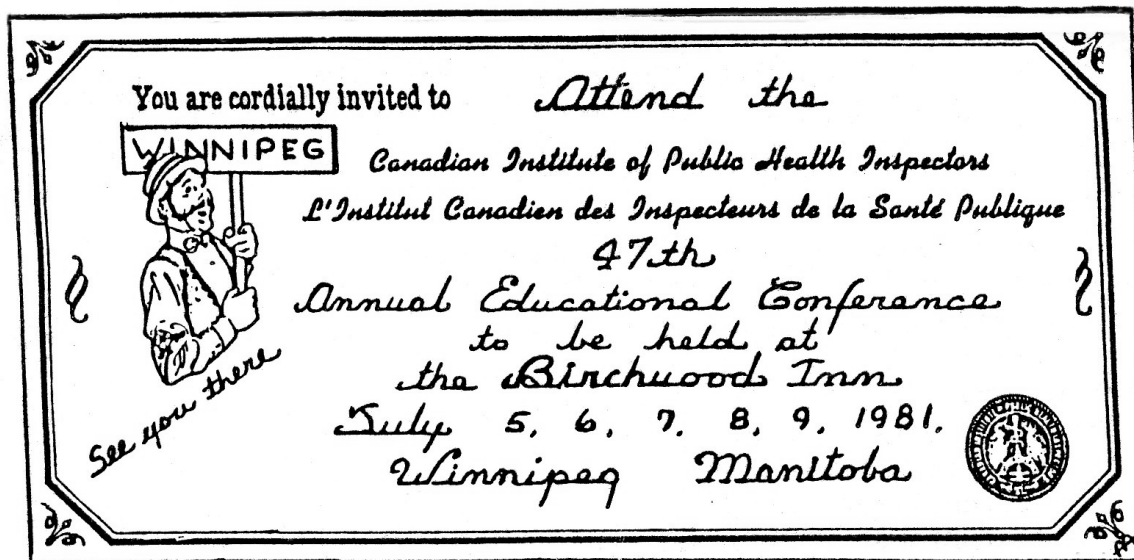
NEWS AND APPOINTMENTS
