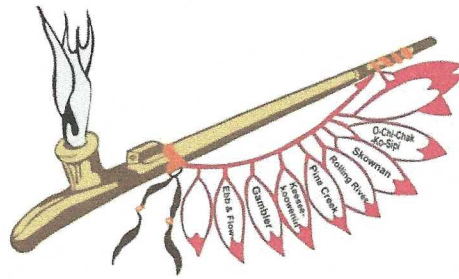

West Region Treaty 2 & 4 Health Services (WRTHS) is an Accredited Organization, seeking applications from CPHI(C) certified Public Health Inspectors/Environmental Public Health Officers for 1 (one) PERMANENT, FULL TIME Environmental Public Health Officer (EPHO) position. Please include proof of certification with resumé.

Under the auspices of the WRTHS, the Environmental Public Health Officer (EPHO) will be responsible for working with the supervising EPHO to provide inspection, education and advisory services to West Region Tribal Council member communities and contracted staff through the Environmental Public Health and Drinking Water Safety Programs.

West Region Treaty 2 & 4 Health Services Sub-Office is located in Dauphin, MB - a community of approximately 8,500 people and is located on the north edge of Riding Mountain National Park. It is 3.5 hours North West of Winnipeg, MB and is 2 hours North of Brandon, MB.

Duties: (Summary)

- Inspection & Education Services: water, onsite wastewater, landfill, food, care facilities, institutions, housing, etc.
- Training and supervision of the Community Based Water Monitors and Administration staff (part time). Instruction on water sampling techniques, on-site lab use, disposal methods and reporting protocol.
- Maintaining records and providing written reports; use of OFFICE, WORD, EXCEL, EHS and WATERTRAX. Must be willing to learn new technologies as they become available and as mandated by ISC-FNIHB or WRTHS.
- Must be able to work independently and as a team.
- Maintenance of the CPHI(C) certification and ensuring all Professional Development requirements are met annually.

Qualifications:

- Must have CPHI(C) credentials - Certified Public Health Inspector (Canada)
- Must be an active member of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors.
- Minimum 2 years PHI/EPHO experience required; 5+ years work experience is an asset.
- Must have a valid Class 5 Drivers License.
- Must be willing to live and work from Dauphin, MB or surrounding area.
- Understanding and knowledgeable of First Nation cultural customs; Health or First Nations studies is an asset.
