### Summary:

Within the Environmental Health Team, the Public Health Inspectors are responsible for:

- Minimizing the incidence of health hazards through education, inspections and investigations under the Health Protection and Promotion Act.
- Inspection programs: Food Safety; Health Hazard Investigation; Infectious Disease Prevention and Control (Personal Service Settings); Zoonotic Diseases; Vector-borne Diseases and Safe Water programs.
- COVID-19: Supporting outbreak investigations and associated work.
- Enforcing activities under the Health Protection and Promotion Act.

### Qualifications:

- Certificate in Public Health Inspection (Canada), note individuals awaiting certification may be considered.
- A Bachelor degree in Applied Sciences or equivalent from an institution approved by the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI) Board of Certification.
- Minimum one year experience as a Certified Public Health Inspector preferred; uncertified applicants completion of a CIPHI Board of Certification 12 week practicum is required.
- Proficiency in oral and written communication including computer skills.
- Possesses knowledge and application of the Health Protection and Promotion Act and associated regulations

### Conditions:

- Terms and conditions of employment are in accordance within the relevant CUPE Collective Agreement
- Immunizations in accordance with Board Policy/Collective Agreements including annual influenza and 3 doses of a COVID-19 immunization unless medically contra indicated
- obtain and maintain a satisfactory vulnerable sector check
- a valid Ontario Driver's License and access to a safe and well maintained vehicle suitable for carrying out duties on behalf of the employer

**Hours:** Usually 8:30 am – 4:30 pm; Monday to Friday, weekend work may be required.
