We are pleased to invite submissions to the 2024 CIPHI National Annual Education Conference (AEC), taking place September 23 - 25, 2024 in Regina, Saskatchewan.

This event supports the shared goal of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI) to support the health and safety of all people. Environmental health is a critical discipline that encompasses a wide range of topics related to the health impacts of human interactions with the environment. The AEC contributes to advocacy, education, and professional competencies for environmental public health professionals and those with a vested interest in this field.

We welcome abstracts from environmental public health professionals, researchers, policymakers, public health partners, and other stakeholders working across the field of environmental health. Abstracts are welcome on any environmental health topic. Of particular interest, we are seeking abstracts with environmental health topics fitting within one of the following:

- 1. Indigenous Environmental Health: Submissions would explore Indigenous perspectives and approaches to environmental health, the impact of colonization, and how Indigenous-led research and community engagement can inform policy and practice.
- 2. Health Equity: Submissions address inequitable distributions of environmental health risks and the structural/systemic factors that contribute to these disparities. We welcome submissions that highlight equitable and respectful approaches to environmental health and interventions to reduce disparities.
- 3. Climate Change: Submissions will explore how climate change and environmental public health work intertwine, and the impacts public health, including through extreme weather events, air pollution, vector-borne diseases, and food insecurity.

Submission guidelines:

- Abstracts must be no longer than 200 words.
- Please ensure all portions of abstract submission form are complete.
- Submit deadline for abstracts is January 31, 2024.
- Responses from submissions will be out by March 31, 2024.
