Reporting to the Manager of Environmental Health, the PHI promotes and protects individual and community health through the education and enforcement of pertinent provincial Acts and Regulations, municipal by-laws, and agency policies. The legislation includes the Health Protection and Promotion Act, the Healthy Menu Choices Act, the Skin Cancer Prevention Act, the Ontario Building Code Act, the Provincial Offences Act, and the Smoke-Free Ontario Act as well as relevant Regulations.
