The successful incumbent will provide public health inspection duties in the Environmental Health program in a generalized multi-disciplinary health program setting, with a focus on Ontario Public Health Standards in Environmental Health.

- Demonstrated initiative, self-direction, flexibility, leadership and decision-making skills;
